A. Action Items:

1. Discussion and possible action regarding: Solar system and Net Metering: *Utility Clerk Justin Anderson was there to explain how the net metering worked and how much we paid back to a resident for their solar power. Fredonia sells power to a resident for 0.068 per KWH and we buy back at a rate of 0.0068. The council discussed some of the options and decided to speak about it during regular council meeting.*
2. Discussion and possible action regarding: Utilities and Power Board: *Justin also spoke about the concerns he had about the utility rates. In 2018 the council voted in a yearly increase of 5% each year for the next 6 years. The increases stopped in 2021. The council talked about voting in the last two increases and will have a vote during regular council meeting.*
3. Discussion and possible action regarding: Emblem for town vehicles: *Daisy Johnson was asked to bring in pictures of possible emblems to be made into vinyl decal to be placed on the town vehicles. After a short time, the council decided and one and will vote on it in regular meeting.*
4. Discussion and possible action regarding: RFP's for town attorney: *An RFP was put out to replace the current town attorney. There were two RFP's that put in. Hayden Ballard with Far West Law put in for a civil attorney for the town and Celeste Robertson and Garet Kartchner with Center for Rural American Justice. After a short discussion the council decided to vote on the civil attorney and table the attorney of prosecution. It will be voted on in regular meeting.*
