Discussion and possible action: Meeting with Kaibab Paiute Tribe: *Roland Maldonado and Vincent Toya with the Kaibab Paiute Tribe and the council met to discuss the ROW, (Right of Way,) for the water line. The two attorneys will be going over the ROW. The ROW is not up until 2030. The next ROW would be for 25 years with two or three auto renewals. There was some talk about the 90 acres the tribe has boarding the Town of Fredonia. There was also talk about the school and how the school has kids going to different schools that should be going to Fredonia. In all there is about 118 kids going to different schools that should be enrolled in Fredonia. They also brought up the fires on the Kaibab and what the tribe could do to help with the recovery efforts. Mayor Johnson stated that there is a committee that has been meeting to make sure that the concerns of the people around here are heard. Roland made it know that he would like to be part of the committee. Mayor Johnson told him that he would let him know when the next meeting will be. Both the tribe and the council would like to keep working together.*
